TITLE: Public Hearing – Neighborhood Link Community Bus Service Expansion

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission hold a public hearing and approve a motion to increase the hours of operation for the Neighborhood Link community bus route operated by the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association (TMA) and to authorize the proper City Officials to amend and execute the interlocal agreement by increasing the level of service by more than 25% to the Neighborhood Link community bus route as approved by this item.

Background

Pursuant to Section 2.1.3 of the City-County Interlocal Agreement (ILA) and Title 49 of the United States Code (U.S.C.) 5307(d)(i)*, the City must hold a public hearing prior to any change in service affecting 25% or more route miles and prior to establishing a new transit route.

The TMA's Neighborhood Link community bus route has experienced very high ridership using its single bus since its inception on January 2, 2013. In an effort to better serve the Fort Lauderdale community, the City and TMA have proposed to increase the number of operating hours and to use an additional bus on the route.

The new daily hours of operation would change from the current 8:15am-2:30pm to 7:00am-4:30pm with the additional bus running from 9:24am-12:24pm during the mid-morning peak period. The existing and proposed schedules are shown on **Exhibit 1**. The cost estimate for this additional service is approximately \$60,000, to be funded by the \$200,000 previously appropriated from the City's Parking Fund.

The date for the commencement of the increased service would be January 2, 2014.

Resource Impact

There will be no additional fiscal impact to the City. Funding will come from Parking Fund dollars already appropriated for FY 2014.
