I agree to abide by all provisions of the noise control ordinance and understand that my failure to do so may result in a civil citation, a physical arrest, or the shutting down of the event.

ATTACHMENT "A"

DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

"MONSTER FORT LAUDERDALE" will be a unique obstacle race capitalizing upon the popularity of cross-fit, extreme, mud and similar races. "Obstacle races" are extremely popular right now with followers traveling hundreds of miles for a long running event, many of which take place in the remote back-woods, far from tourists, spectators, hotels and local businesses. Our concept is different. We want to utilize the beauty and uniqueness of Fort Lauderdale Beach to create events that are more about the excitement of the obstacles than a long run.

"MONSTER FORT LAUDERDALE" will offer something to everyone. The Fort Lauderdale Beach venue will allow us to offer both our longer "MONSTER MILE" and/or "MONSTER 5K" course, as well as our shorter "MONSTER SPRINT SERIES." The longer courses will start and finish in our central village, weaving back and forth around our central village with over 20 obstacles stationed every 50-150 yards. Race paths will be 8-12' wide and will be marked by intermittent rope stanchions with "crossways" every 25' allowing for normal beachgoer traffic to move easily and comfortably around and through the area. Obstacle foot prints are generally 8-16' by 12'.

The "MONSTER SPRINT SERIES" will be a 200-400 yard "all-out, all-obstacles" challenge in our central village that participants can challenge again and again. With "nothing but obstacles," this is a race of a different color. Participants and spectators will experience an intensive 2-4 minute "all-out, all-obstacles" sprint challenge. With one obstacle after another, one competitor after another, the excitement never stops.
