Lauderdale – Color Field Exhibit and the Display of Event Banner Signs for a Period Longer than 30 Days - Nova Southeastern University – Case No.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission consider the City's co-sponsorship of NSU Art Museum Fort Lauderdale – Color Field Exhibit and the display of event banner signs associated with the exhibit for a period of 88 days.

Background

Nova Southeastern University is requesting the City of Fort Lauderdale co-sponsor the NSU Art Museum Fort Lauderdale's Color Field Exhibit and approve the display of event banner signs for a 88-day period. Pursuant to Section 25-23 of the Code of Ordinances ("Code"), event banner signs may be displayed in association with city co-sponsored events that serve a legitimate public purpose, as approved by the city commission. The co-sponsorship of such events highlights the City of Fort Lauderdale as a supporter of cultural and artistic activities that are open to the public and cultivate community culture and the arts.

Nova Southeastern University proposes to install approximately 50 event banner signs within the City for a 88-day period beginning on January 2, 2024, in order to bring public awareness to the Color Field modernist art collection. In accordance with Section 25-23(b)(3) b., Event *Banner Signs*, of the Code of Ordinances, event banner signs may be displayed for periods longer than 30 days if approved by the City Commission.

To review the proposed banner sign, please see Exhibit 1. The proposed locations of the signs are shown in Exhibit 2.
