**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 8 (Exhibit 1) with Keith and Schnars, P.A. for small water main improvements design services in Victoria Park (Exhibit 2) in the amount of \$165,560.

**Background**

This project involves the replacement of 29,000 linear feet of existing undersized water mains within residential neighborhoods south of Northeast 6<sup>th</sup> Street between North Federal Highway and Northeast 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The project was designed by City staff and will be permitted by Keith and Schnars, P.A.

This task order is being entered into pursuant to the continuing contract for civil engineering consultant services (Contract 626-10881) with Keith and Schnars, P.A., in accordance with the terms of the amended master agreement dated November 6, 2012 (CAR #12-2299) and renewed on October 21, 2014 (CAM #14-1066).

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$165,560 for the task order and \$16,556 for in house project management fees, for a total of \$182,116.
