## **RESOLUTION NO. 20-130**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE OF CORDOVA ROAD, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2015, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"), authorized the submittal of an application to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") for the Cordova Road Complete Streets Project ("Cordova Road Project"), through its Transportation Alternatives Program, which was awarded; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2017, the City endorsed the Cordova Road Project to receive funding from the MPO; and

WHEREAS, Cordova Road is a roadway currently under the jurisdiction of the City of Fort Lauderdale and is thereby maintained by the City; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the Cordova Road Project is to improve vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle safety on Cordova Road between SE 17<sup>th</sup> Street and SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Florida Department of Transportation began the design phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the total project design and construction costs are fully funded for eligible expenses in the amount of \$1,600,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Florida Department of Transportation wish to execute a Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for the Cordova Road Project which includes, resurfacing Cordova Road to include bicycle lanes and sharrows, installing pedestrian lighting, constructing a new median, installing two (2) enhanced mid-block crosswalks with rapid rectangular flashing beacons and improving the intersection at SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street to implement traffic calming features.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the improvements and maintenance of Cordova Road is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the agreement.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
