TITLE: Motion Approving Addendum to Contract for the Purchase and Installation
of Sports Lighting via Clay County Contract – Musco Sports Lighting, LLC -
\$709,000 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an addendum to a contract with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, in substantially the form attached, to purchase and install sports lighting at two (2) park locations for an estimated amount of \$709,000 *via* the Clay County Contract 18/19-2 and authorize the City Manager to execute the addendum.

Background

The athletic field lighting in many of our parks is outdated and inefficient. In many cases, manufacturers are no longer making replacement fixtures, which result in lower lighting levels and dangerous playing conditions. In 2021, a project to upgrade athletic field lighting at eight different parks was approved by the City Commission. (Bayview, Croissant, Floranada, Florence C. Hardy, Holiday, Mills Pond, Osswald, and Sunset). The department has identified 2 additional park locations where upgrades are needed. The additional locations include the football and baseball fields at J.C. Carter Park and the pickleball and roller hockey courts at Holiday Park. Upgrading lights to LED will result in a 40% to 60% decrease in electricity usage, increased lighting levels and safety, as well as reduced maintenance costs. The described upgrades are included in the Parks Bond program as funded improvements.

The City received two (2) respective quotes from Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, for an estimated total amount of \$709,000 *via* the Clay County Contract 18/19-2, to purchase and install sports lighting at the 2 park locations where upgrades are needed. Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(5)(b), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may piggyback a contract entered into by another governmental or public entity and a provider of supplies or services required by the City, if the Chief Procurement Officer determines that it is practicable and advantageous for the City to employ this method of procurement. The Chief Procurement Officer has determined that it would be practicable and advantageous for the City to use this method of procurement for this agreement. The

proposed purchase will be made in accordance with Clay County Contract No. 18/19-2 from Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in the amount of \$709,000.
