TITLE: Motion to award a contract for Stranahan Park Fencing Project 11924 –

Invitation to Bid (ITB) 243-11311 - \$56,800

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract for the purchase and installation of decorative fencing for Stranahan Park to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder Gold Coast Hurricane Shutters, Inc., in the amount of \$56,800.

## **Background**

The Stranahan Park fencing project is a 2014 Parks and Recreation project to enhance the appearance of the Park. The work included in this project includes the removal of existing wood fence, followed by the delivery and installation of aluminum decorative fence and gates.

The project bid opening was held on November 13, 2013. Four bids were received with Gold Coast Hurricane submitting the lowest bid. Gold Coast's bid, however, included some minor irregularities. The bid was accompanied with a company check submitted as a bid security; however, a company check is not an acceptable form of bid security per ITB specifications. The bidder also did not submit the NCL-1- Non-Collusion Statement, names of witnesses on the proposal page, and the Minority Business / Women Business Enterprise Prime Contractor Identification Form (MBE1-MBE2 pages). Gold Coast was contacted and given a deadline to correct these irregularities. The deadline was met and the vendor complied, submitting a cashier's check to replace his company check and correcting all other irregularities to comply with the specification requirements.

The correction of these irregularities does not adversely affect the other bidders nor does it give Gold Coast an unfair advantage in staff's opinion. Therefore, approval is requested by the City Commission to waive the minor irregularities and award the contract to Gold Coast Hurricane Shutters, Inc.

# **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$56,800 for the contract and \$14,690 for estimated Engineering fees, for a total of \$71,490.
