TITLE: Motion Accepting a Donation of two (2) Dell Laptops and one (1) Apple 10.2-inch iPad Wi-Fi (9th Generation) and one (1) Apple iPad mini-Wi-Fi (6th Generation) for Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue from the Florida Department of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support in the amount of \$3,130.82 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to accept a donation of two (2) Dell Laptops, one (1) Apple iPad tablet and one (1) Apple iPad Mini for Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue and to execute any documents required to accept the equipment between the Florida Department of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support and the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Background

Mobile Integrated Healthcare - Community Paramedicine (MIH-CP) is the provision of healthcare using patient-centered, mobile resources in the out-of-hospital environment. MIH-CP is provided by a wide array of healthcare entities that are administratively or clinically integrated with EMS agencies.

The Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue (FLFR) Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Bureau launched a MIH program in July of 2021. The program presently focuses on our frequent callers and our vulnerable population. Members of the program also participated in the delivery of vaccines to the vulnerable population within the City of Fort Lauderdale. Since the inception of the MIH program, multiple residents within the City of Fort Lauderdale have been assisted in a variety of ways. This assistance includes resource allocation, fall assessments, smoke alarm installations, and an evaluation of their activities of daily living (ADLs).

The Florida Department of Health, Division of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support has been supporting FLFR with starting our MIH-CP program and has donated the following items to Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue:

- Two (2) Dell Laptops @ \$1,163/ea. = \$2,326
- One (1) Apple 10.2-inch iPad Wi-Fi 9th Generation tablet @ \$319.79
- One (1) Apple iPad Mini Wi-Fi (6th Generation) @ \$485.03

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive impact to the City. The value of the donated equipment – two (2) Dell Laptops, one (1) Apple 10.2 inch iPad tablet and one (1) Apple iPad mini is \$3,130.82.
