City reserves the right to reject or disapprove this application or immediately terminate all use permitted to Applicant thereunder, if the City determines, in its sole and absolute discretion, the approval of this application, or any use permitted thereunder, will have an adverse effect upon the public's health, safety, or general welfare. Applicant's use of the City's facility is restricted to the Event, as described on page 1 of this application. If City terminates Applicant's use, Applicant shall immediately terminate all further use of City's facility upon receipt of City's termination notice.
