A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING _____ TO THE POSITION OF INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY, RETROACTIVELY IF APPLICABLE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE RETURN OF THE INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY TO THE POSITION OF _____ AT SUCH TIME AS A PERMANENT CITY ATTORNEY IS SELECTED OR UPON FURTHER ACTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That _____ is hereby appointed to the position of Interim City Attorney of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, effective _____, retroactively, until further action by the City Commission.

SECTION 2. That the annual salary of the Interim City Attorney shall be \$ _____, as adjusted by any subsequent general wage increases, retroactive to _____.

SECTION 3. That upon appointment of a permanent City Attorney, or upon further action by the City Commission, the Interim City Attorney will return to his previous position of _____ and his salary will revert to his regular rate of pay in effect on _____, as adjusted by any intervening wage increases.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective on _____, retroactively.
