TITLE: City of Fort Lauderdale's Complete Streets Manual

The Transportation & Mobility staff will give a presentation detailing the City of Fort Lauderdale's Complete Streets Manual. This manual will aid the City in ensuring the development of a livable, connected, healthy and safe community for all modes of transportation and all neighbors.

This initiative was born from the City's Fast Forward 2035 Visioning process, receiving the second largest number of ideas (133), which is one less idea than the number one group, economic diversification. More walkable/bikeable streets was also the top ranked capital improvement option in the 2012 Neighbor Survey.

On August 21, 2012, the City Commission heard a presentation on Complete Streets by the Urban Health Partnership, the organization that developed the Broward County Complete Streets Guidelines on behalf of the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization. The Transportation & Mobility Department was actively involved in that county-wide initiative.

As a follow-up to this informational presentation, a Complete Streets Policy will be presented for adoption by the City Commission.
