Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award the purchase of court resurfacing of tennis and baseball courts to Fast-Dry Courts, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of \$146,517.84.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department has various tennis and basketball courts throughout the City. These courts should be resurfaced every 5-8 years. Staff is proposing the resurfacing of the tennis courts and basketball courts that have the greatest need at this time. The tennis courts are located at Jimmy Evert Tennis Center, Hardy Park, Benneson Park, and Bass Park. The basketball courts are at Holiday Park, Riverside Park, Bass Park, Lauderdale Manors Park and Bayview Park.

The City's basketball and tennis courts are heavily used by residents and visitors throughout the year. They are a valued and appreciated amenity to neighborhoods. City staff conducted a thorough inspection of all City courts and determined that those listed, some of which have not been resurfaced for as many as ten years, are in the greatest need of repair.

Invitation to Bid 532-11220 was opened on May 10, 2013 with two bids received. Low bidder, Fast-Dry Courts, Inc., has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$146,517.84
