TITLE: Motion to award continuing contract agreements for survey and mapping

consulting services Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 246-11375 – Consultant Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA) - \$350,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award three, two-year contracts for survey and mapping consulting services with Craven, Thompson & Associates, Inc., Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. and Keith and Schnars, P.A. in substantially the forms attached, and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options for each contract, contingent upon mutual agreement and appropriation of funds.

Background

On May 20, 2014 (CAM 14-0555), the City Commission approved the final ranking and commencement of contract negotiations for survey and mapping consulting services with the top three ranked proposers Craven, Thompson & Associates, Inc., Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. and Keith and Schnars, P.A.

Staff has completed negotiations for all three consultants and is requesting Commission approval to execute the contracts and for staff to issue task orders up to the amount requested. Considering the approved Fiscal Year 2014 Final Operating and Community Investment Plan budgets, the recommended two year contract is estimated at \$350,000 (approximately \$116,666.66 each).

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$350,000. Task orders issued on this contract will be in accordance with the negotiated hourly rates on an as-needed, per available funded basis, and expensed from individual projects.

The available funding identified in Exhibit 4 demonstrates the City's ability to fund the costs of this contract.
