**TITLE:** Motion Approving Purchase of Traffic Calming Speed Cushions - Traffic  
Logix Corporation - \$108,770 - (**Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4**)

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the purchase of traffic calming speed cushions and installation hardware from Traffic Logix Corporation (TLC), in the estimated amount of \$108,770.

**Background**

The purpose of the described purchase is to provide traffic calming speed cushions for various locations throughout the city. Most of the speed cushions will be installed in the Coral Ridge Country Club Estates neighborhood as part of an existing traffic calming project (Project No. P12636.331).

On July 26, 2021, the Transportation and Mobility Department (TAM) and Procurement Services Division (PSD) issued Quick Quote No. 2107-007. On July 29, 2021, the City issued an addendum increasing the quantity of each of the line items as it was determined by staff that more calming cushions would be needed.

On August 6, 2021, bid responses were due and the City received five bids. One of the five bidders indicated its status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise. The lowest bid in the amount of \$99,292 was submitted by Elite Textile Trading LLC; however, they were deemed non-responsive as they could not provide products that met the City's specifications. The second lowest bid in the amount of \$108,770, submitted by TLC, met the bid requirements, and is deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the General Fund FY22 Budget associated with this action. Funds are budgeted and available for this purchase as below stated.
