**TITLE:** Motion to approve one-year contract for pole setting and removal services,  
Invitation to Bid 533-11099 - \$83,740

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year contract for pole setting and removal services to Imperial Electrical Incorporated, in the estimated annual amount of \$83,740 and authorize the City Manager, or designee, to approve the renewal options contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.

**Background**

The City of Fort Lauderdale currently utilizes contractual services for pole setting and removal. A variety of poles, equipment and services are used for many different lighting purposes throughout the City. Poles are replaced due to aging infrastructure, vehicular accidents, and changes in lighting requirements which may also require the addition of new poles and fixtures. This contract also provides additional service and equipment capabilities necessary to fulfill the City's many lighting maintenance responsibilities in an efficient and effective manner.

Invitation to Bid 533-11099 was opened on November 2, 2012 with four bids received. Low bidder Imperial Electrical Incorporated has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the low responsive and responsible bidder.

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$83,740
