Requested location: The start/finish line will be set at Esplanade Park in Fort Lauderdale. The route will begin going east on SW 2nd St., then south on SE 1st Ave. until it intersects with Las Olas Blvd. Riders will take a left onto Las Olas and continue down until they reach A1A where they will then make a left and go north towards Boca. The route can either be 30 or 65 miles depending on what the rider has selected and will go as far north as Boynton Beach. On return route, riders will travel south on A1A, make a right on Las Olas Blvd. and finish back at Esplanade Park.

It will be the start/finish line and host all pre and post ride festivities for the cyclists, their families, and friends. EP will have space available for multiple sponsors, bike mechanics, and cycle clubs to set up 10'X10' tents. Trash/recycling containers will be stationed around the event area to collect any excess waste. The Esplanade Park stage will be used by our DJ, HAM radio personnel, and warm-up coordinators to get the crowd ready for the day's event. Food tents, bike racks, water stations, a balloon arch, and silent auction tables will also be set up.

I agree to abide by all provisions of the noise control ordinance and understand that my failure to do so may result in a civil citation, a physical arrest, or the shutting down of the event.



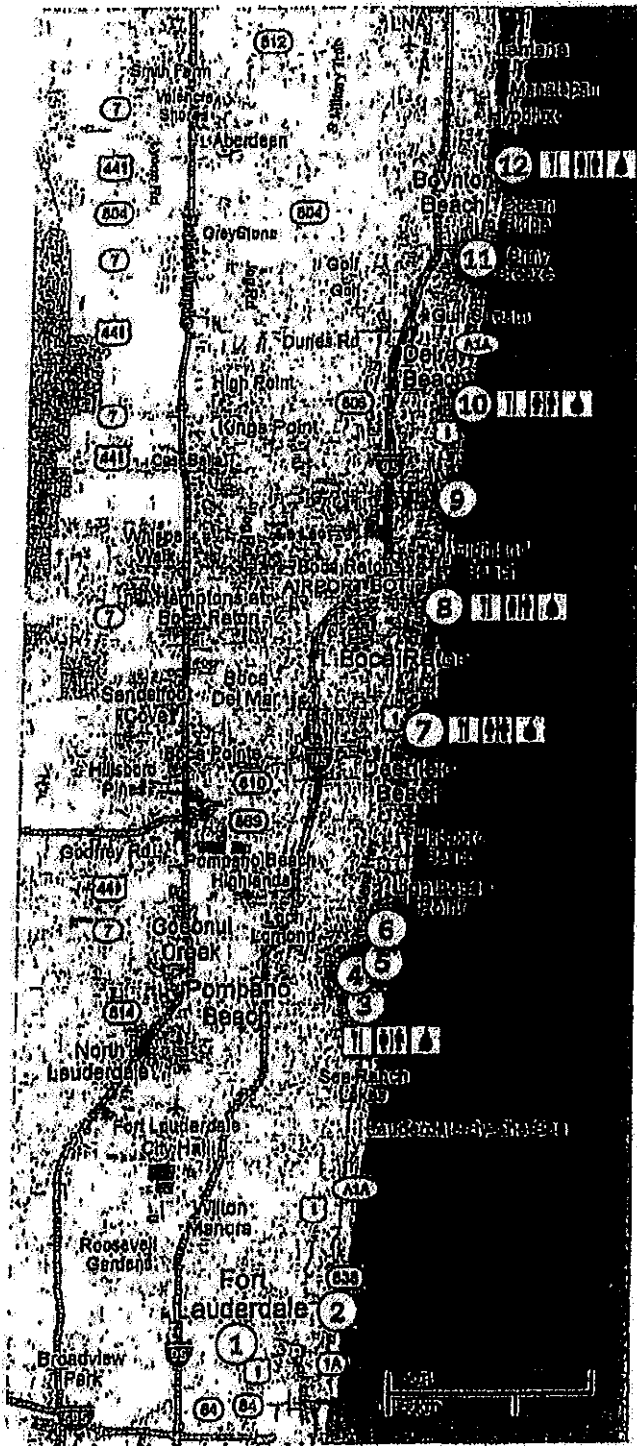

GF CYCLE FOR LIFE | WHEELS IN MOTION FOR A CURE | MARCH 18, 2012

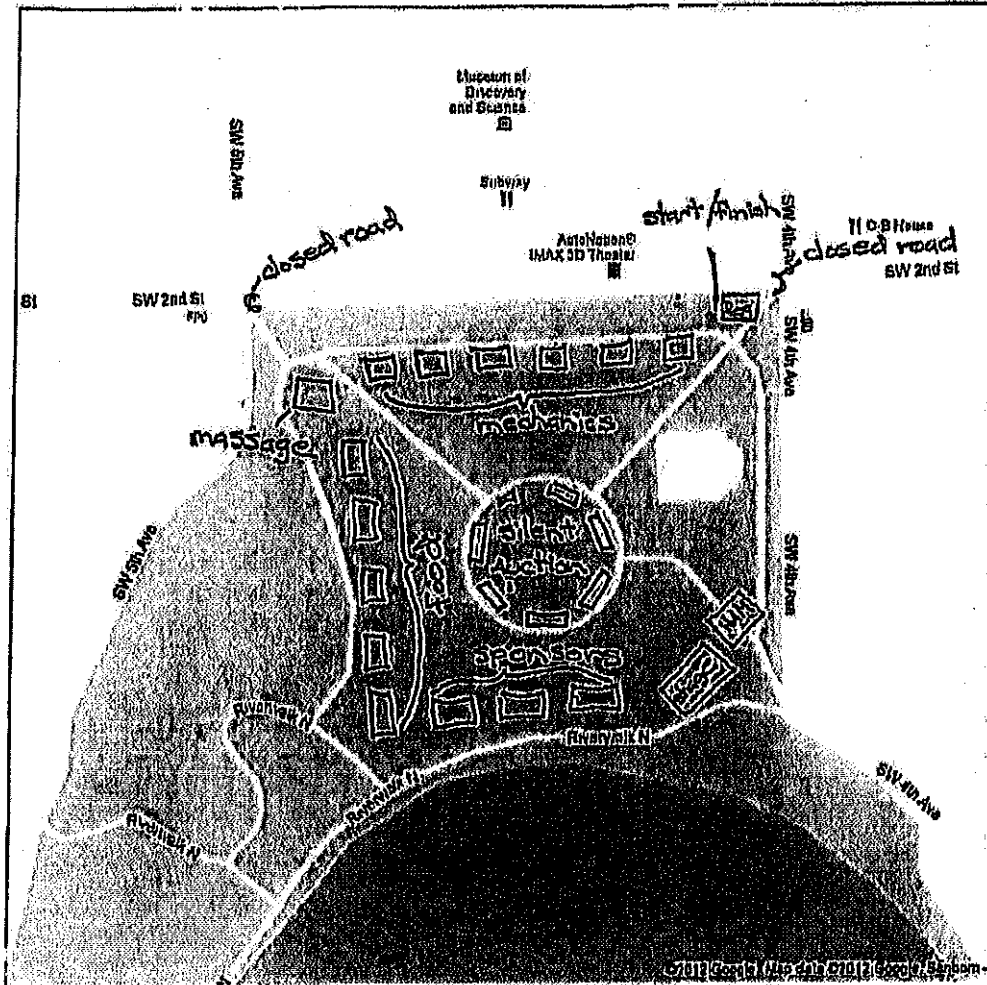
CYCLE ROUTE



1. START 30 AND 65 MILE: Huizenga Plaza (Las Olas Boulevard, between Andrews Avenue & 1st Avenue). Head East on Las Olas towards A1A. Proceed 2.55 miles. Warning: must pass over large bridge.
2. Turn left onto A1A towards Atlantic Boulevard, Proceed 7.7 miles.
- REST STOP: LEFT TURN AT BANK OF AMERICA (2nd Street and A1A). Warning: limited shoulders on road
3. Continue down 2nd Street, then turn right onto Hibiscus Avenue. Proceed <1 mile.
4. Travel across Atlantic Avenue where Hibiscus Avenue becomes N. Riverside Drive. Proceed <1 mile.
5. Turn right onto NE 5th Street. Proceed <1 mile.
6. Turn left back onto A1A. Proceed 7.47 miles.
7. Continue along A1A to East Camino Real/ South Inlet Park, Boca Raton. Proceed 3.4 miles.
- REST STOP: REAR ENTRANCE OF SOUTH INLET PARK ALONG A1A
- 30 MILE TURNAROUND: HEAD SOUTH ON A1A CONTINUE 65 MILE
8. Continue north along A1A to Spanish River Park, Boca Raton. Proceed 3.9 miles. Warning: bridge ahead.
- REST STOP: ON LEFT ALONG A1A NEAR MAIN ENTRANCE OF SPANISH RIVER PARK
9. Continue North on A1A through Highland Beach toward E Linton Boulevard. Proceed 1.4 miles.
10. Pass E Linton Boulevard and continue along A1A to Anchor Park. Proceed 4.0 miles.
- REST STOP ON LEFT NEAR ENTRANCE TO ANCHOR PARK, DELRAY BEACH
11. Head up A1A past Briny Breezes toward E Woolbright Road. Proceed 2.3 miles. Warning: limited shoulders on road.
12. Pass E Woolbright Road and head north on A1A to Ocean Inlet Park.
- REST STOP INSIDE OF OCEAN INLET PARK: Make left from A1A then quick right after passing guardhouse. Rest Stop located in the first pavilion by the water.
- 65 MILE TURNAROUND: REVERSE DIRECTIONS ARE TO BE USED FOR RETURN ROUTE
