**TITLE**: First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County to

provide interoperable radio communications

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the first amendment to an interlocal agreement for radio communications interoperability between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Palm Beach County and authorize the proper City officials to execute the agreement.

## **Background**

On September 6, 2006, the City Commission approved an interlocal agreement with Palm Beach County to provide interoperable radio communications to the City during multi-jurisdictional events and operations. Having this access allows Fort Lauderdale Police Officers the ability to effectively communicate while working in the Palm Beach County jurisdiction.

The proposed amendment renews this agreement with revisions that are agreeable to both parties.

## **Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
