RESOLUTION NO. 25 -

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR COMMUNITY SHUTTLE SERVICE TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT AND TO AMEND THE HOURLY RATE FOR THE COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City") and Broward County, Florida ("County") entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA"), effective on October 1, 2019, as amended on August 4, 2020, February 22, 2021, June 16, 2021, April 26, 2024, and September 25, 2024 to provide Community Shuttle Service as an alternative form of public transportation for residents within the jurisdictional limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the term of the ILA expires on September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County wish to enter into a Sixth Amendment to extend the term of the ILA to end on September 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the new reimbursable hourly community bus service rate, will be increased from \$54.02 to \$55.64, which will be effective as of February 15, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the Sixth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Community Shuttle Service to extend the term of the Agreement and amend the hourly rate for the Community Bus Service for Fiscal Year 2026.
