# AMENDMENT #001 TO THE FY 2014 – 2015 PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH

#### WOMEN IN DISTRESS OF BROWARD COUNTY, INC.

THIS AMENDMENT, with an effective date of <u>December 2, 2014</u> by the City of Fort Lauderdale (also known as the "City") and Women in Distress of Broward County, Inc. (also known as the "Participant").

WHEREAS, the City entered into an Agreement dated September 9, 2014, with the Participant in accordance with the 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan approved on July 1, 2014 (CAM # 14-0775);

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") to undertake particular activities, including the provision of childcare services to eligible persons under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended ("HCD Act"), Public Law 93-383; and

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2014, the City Commission approved additional funding for the Participant (CAM #14-1411); and

WHEREAS, both parties wish to modify the Agreement to increase the allocation of funding by \$36,834.35 and also to add the additional services, as described below; and

WHEREAS that Plans provide for funding for Participant's program and authorize the proper City Officials to enter into this Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties mutually agree that the original Agreement, is hereby amended as follows:

## A. PART II (TERM AND TIME OF PERFORMANCE)

The following sentence is added to Part II.

The additional funding providing to the Participant will be expended as follows:

- Minimum of \$25,784.05 must be expended by July 15, 2015;
- Remaining CDBG funds must be expended by September 30, 2015;

In order to meet the July 15, 2015 expenditure timeframe, reimbursement requests must be submitted at least 5 calendar days in advance of the timeline. The Participant's final reimbursement request must be submitted by October 15, 2015.

If the Participant fails to meet any of the agreed upon expenditure terms, the City shall not be obligated to provide additional funding as contemplated under this Agreement.

#### B. PART IV (PAYMENT)

The first sentence of Part IV is deleted and replaced with the following:

It is expressly agreed and understood that the total amount to be paid by the City under this Agreement shall not exceed \$81,834.00.

#### C. EXHIBIT A

The following scope of work is added to Exhibit A.

The Participant will address the critical needs of domestic violence victims – emergency shelter and food in an environment where they can recover from the traumatic effects of victimization. As families work on rebuilding their lives, they are provided with individual counseling and support groups that will allow them to begin to heal in a safe setting. As a result of the additional funds, the Participant will serve a total of 100 clients (50 adults and 50 children) and provide 838 Emergency Shelter Nights to those clients.

#### D. EFFECT OF AGREEMENT.

Unless modified herein, all other terms and conditions of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Participation Agreement dated September 9, 2014, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
