A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR FILM PERMITTING, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"), seek to create a streamlined process for film permitting that enhances the City's attractiveness as a premier filming destination; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Film Commission and City of Fort Lauderdale will process film permit applications for productions through a newly launched, user-friendly FilmApp system, powered by Apply4; and

WHEREAS, the City will continue to oversee film permits within its jurisdiction and will collaborate with the Broward County Film Commission to facilitate productions and permitting; and

WHEREAS, the City retains the right to approve or reject permit applications for filming activities on public and private property and will maintain control over film activities on municipally owned land, including parks, beaches, and public streets; and

WHEREAS, the fees associated with film permits will be determined and collected in accordance with City regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and City of Fort Lauderdale for Film Permitting ("Interlocal Agreement") in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #25-0321, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement.
