TITLE: Motion Approving the City of Fort Lauderdale Interlocal Grant Participation Agreement with the Downtown Development Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the SW 2nd Avenue Streetscape Improvement Project - \$95,000 - **(Commission District 4)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve and authorize execution of a City of Fort Lauderdale Interlocal Grant Participation Agreement with the Downtown Development Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale (DDA) in substantially the form attached.

Background

The DDA is leading the implementation of the SW 2nd Avenue Streetscape Improvement Project ("Streetscape Project") using a combination of grant funding from the U.S. Department of Transportation/Federal Transit Administration and the DDA General Funds. The DDA has asked the City to provide funding for physical upgrades to the public right-of-way including installation of lighting that will enhance safety and aesthetics, in the amount of \$95,000.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$95,000 in FY 2020. Funding is contingent upon approval of the companion Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 19-0847.
