

RESOLUTION NO. 18-212

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE ANDREWS AVENUE DRAWBRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT ENHANCEMENTS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County is completing a rehabilitation project of the Andrews Avenue drawbridge; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") has requested that Broward County include certain enhancements in the Andrews Avenue Drawbridge Rehabilitation Project and the County has agreed to incorporate those enhancements in the project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will include enhancements for noise mitigating wheel paths and underdeck luminaires and bracket arms; and

WHEREAS, the total construction cost of the project is estimated at \$7,846,148; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the City's requested additional enhancements will be \$59,080 to construct noise mitigating wheel paths which constitutes 40% of the total cost, as well as an additional \$25,300 for underdeck luminaires and bracket arms on the Riverwalk, on both the north and south side of the river; and

WHEREAS, the City and County wish to enter into an Interlocal Agreement to include the enhancements requested by the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for the Andrews Avenue Drawbridge Rehabilitation Project Enhancements.


