TITLE: LauderTrail Strategic Initiative Update – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

The LauderTrail Working Group and Transportation and Mobility staff will provide an update on the LauderTrail Strategic Initiative. This initiative is a 2018 Commission Annual Action Priority.

The LauderTrail Working Group consists of Commission appointees, Parks & Recreation Board representatives, and Planning and Zoning Board representatives focused on developing a seven-mile pedestrian and bicycle trail connecting various local and regional destinations within the City of Fort Lauderdale. More specifically, the LauderTrail Working Group is tasked with identifying preferred paths, destinations, amenities, and potential sources of funding for designing and constructing the LauderTrail.
