**TITLE**: Resolution Approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the

Florida Department of Transportation for FXE Airport Drainage Improvement Phase 1 at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport - \$540,000 -

(Commission District 1)

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) and accepting the anticipated grant funding of up to \$540,000 for FXE Airport Drainage Improvement Phase 1 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) and authorize the City Manager to execute a Public Transportation Grant Agreement.

### **Background**

FXE has recently experienced flooding issues following various consecutive storm events. The Airport conducted a due diligence study which indicated that multiple drainage improvements are needed at FXE to alleviate flooding during future storm events. The study also shows that most of the improvements are needed in the east and southeast portions of the Airport.

The project will include the removal of existing asphalt paving, concrete or various impervious areas. The construction will also include creating additional depth to exiting swale and basin areas. Phase 1 of project will primarily focus on the southeast area of the airport, including parcel 16,17,18, and 22 (Exhibit 1).

With an estimated design and construction cost of \$675,500 FDOT is providing a PTGA in the amount of \$540,00 for up to 80% of the projected costs, and the Airport will provide a 20% match in the amount of \$135,000, which is contingent upon approval of the December 6, 2022 Consolidated Budget CAM 22-0896.

At its meeting of October 27, 2022, the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to accept this grant from FDOT.

## Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City for the grant in the amount of \$540,000 and a grant match in the amount of \$135,000. An additional \$40,500 in project management and engineering fees will be provided from the Airport fund. These appropriations are contingent upon the approval of the December 6, 2022, Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 22-0896.
