Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in expenditure for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) ambulance billing and electronic patient care reporting services to Advanced Data Processing, Inc. d/b/a Intermedix in the amount of \$115,000.

Background

At its May 17, 2011 Regular Meeting (CAR 11-0629, Pur-13), the City Commission approved a three year contract to provide EMS ambulance billing and electronic patient care reporting system services. The original three-year award was for \$1,119,345 (average annual award of \$373,115).

Due to increases in the number of EMS transports and EMS transport revenues, and with the additional revenues generated from Inter-facility Transports Fees, the Fire-Rescue Department is requesting an increase in expenditure for fiscal year 2013.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$115,000.
