## RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DENYING THE APPLICATION BY W. SCOTT PARKER AND PATRICIA S. PARKER, HUSBAND AND WIFE, FOR A DOCK PERMIT FOR THE INSTALLATION, USE, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF AN EXISTING +/- 100' LONG X +/- 7'3" WIDE DOCK EXTENDING A MAXIMUM DISTANCE OF +/- 9'3" FROM THE WET FACE OF THE SEAWALL ON PUBLIC PROPERTY ABUTTING THE WATERWAY ADJACENT TO 1725 SE 8TH STREET, PURSUANT TO SECTION 8-144 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE.

WHEREAS, Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida provides that the City Commission may grant a dock permit; and

WHEREAS, W. Scott Parker and Patricia S. Parker, husband and wife (hereinafter "Applicant"), owns the Property located at 1725 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33316, Property ID# 5042 11 22 1520 (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant applied for a permit to install, use, maintain and repair an existing +/-100' long x +/-7'3" wide dock extending a maximum distance of +/-9'3" from the wet face of the seawall on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 1725 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, (hereinafter "Application"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That each WHEREAS clause set forth above is true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after reviewing and weighing the documentary evidence and testimony of those addressing the Commission at its Regular Meeting of December 7, 2021, as to the Application for a permit to install, use, maintain and repair an existing +/-100' long x +/-7'3" wide dock extending a maximum distance of +/-9'3" from the wet face of the seawall on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 1725 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, has determined that the Application be and same is hereby denied.
