Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt an ordinance on second reading amending Chapter 26, Article VII, Traffic Intersection Safety Act.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale enacted Ordinance No. C-10-20 on or about July 4, 2010 following the passage of the "Mark Wandall Traffic Safety Act", which authorized the use of traffic infraction detectors to enforce red light traffic signal infractions pursuant to Chapter 316 of the Florida Statutes. In anticipation of changes to Chapter 316 of the Florida Statutes regarding red light camera enforcement, the City of Fort Lauderdale wishes to amend its ordinances to provide for the current Florida Statutes section numbers and anticipate future statutory amendments.

On June 4, 2013, the City Commission approved this item on first reading (O-2).
