I have reviewed the attached Business Tax application for Cycle-Party Fort Lauderdale, LLC. This written evaluation is based upon the criteria covered in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Cycle-Party Fort Lauderdale wishes to conduct tours for groups of up to 15 persons cycling together on one quadricycle. That quadricycle will be steered by a company driver. The guest only pedal.

Traffic safety is of utmost importance with this request. Some of the risks have been reduced in Darlene Pfeiffer's October 27, 2012 Memorandum No. TAM 12 by limiting the operation of the quadricycles to the Himmarshee Area of downtown Fort Lauderdale. I would like to further improve the traffic safety by restricting the business hours to 8:00a.m.- 10 p.m. every day of the week; not extending the hours until 2:00a.m. on the weekends. The Himmarshee area becomes quite congested with vehicular traffic and pedestrian traffic in late evening and early morning hours of the weekend.

With the above mentioned restrictions there does not appear to be any other law enforcement or quality of life issues to address. This business would be a welcomed addition to our downtown area.
