TITLE: Motion to Approve a Second Extension and Amendment for Annual Concrete and Brick Paver Contract - Straightline Engineering Group, LLC

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the second extension and amendment to the annual concrete and brick paver contract with Straightline Engineering Group, LLC (Straightline), in substantially the form attached, to renew for one additional year and increase the contract amount by \$100,000.

Background

On August 19, 2014 (CAM 14-0850) the City Commission approved a one-year renewal of the annual concrete and brick paver contract with Straightline in the amount of \$236,946. The contract allows for two additional one year extensions. This is a unit price contract for the purpose of repairing damaged sidewalks and installing Americans with Disabilities Act sidewalk ramps citywide when needed. To date, staff has encumbered and/or expensed approximately \$228,443 for needed repairs. As such, staff is seeking approval to increase the contract amount by \$100,000 (from \$236,946 to \$336,946) based on issued task orders and projected work, and extend the contract for one additional year.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$100,000.
