

RESOLUTION NO. 26-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A STATE-FUNDED GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE FORT LAUDERDALE ROADWAY RESURFACING PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$750,000; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Roadway Resurfacing Project ("Project") is to maintain the pavement condition index ("PCI") score for the 564 miles of roadway within City jurisdiction streets specifically affected by uneven and bumpy pavement, irregularities like ruts, potholes, multiple utility repairs and any other damage that compromises the pavement; and

WHEREAS, the Project focuses on milling and resurfacing roadways city-wide with a PCI below fifty-five (55), as identified in the Citywide 2019 inspection data report; and

WHEREAS, to help fund the cost of this continued Project, the City applied for \$850,000 in Fiscal Year 2025/2026 General Appropriation Act grant funding in April 2025; and

WHEREAS, in November 2025, Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") notified the City it had been awarded \$750,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Florida Department of Transportation State-Funded Grant Agreement in the amount of \$750,000 for a grant for Construction Phase of the Fort Lauderdale Roadway Resurfacing Project; and

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
