- TITLE: Motion Awarding Contract for Pumping Services Green Team Plumbing, LLC d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation, A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc., EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc., and All Liquid Environmental Services LLC d/b/a Johnson Environmental Services - \$400,000 – (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve contracts, in substantially the forms attached, with Green Team Plumbing, LLC d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation, A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc., EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc., and All Liquid Environmental Services LLC d/b/a Johnson Environmental Services, for the purchase of pumping services for the initial two-year term amount of \$400,000, and authorize the City Manager to approve two one-year renewal options in the estimated annual amount of \$200,000, for a potential total contract amount of \$800,000, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Public Works Utilities Division staff maintains 475.8 miles of sewer gravity mains and 186 wastewater pumping stations throughout the City. Staff is able to manage the workload under normal conditions utilizing City's vactor trucks and equipment. However, for extreme conditions such as severe rain events, extensive power outages, and hurricanes, it is necessary to have additional resources to maintain infrastructure resilience and provide a high level of service.

On March 28, 2022, the City's Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) 12576-323 for pumping services. A total of five (5) bids were received from the following vendors:

- Green Team Plumbing, LLC d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation;
- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.;
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.;
- All Liquid Environmental Services LLC d/b/a Johnson Environmental Services; and
- Hinterland Group, Inc.

The bid consisted of six (6) items and not all bidders bid on every item. In addition, staff did not award some items to bidders that provided costs considerably higher than the other bidders or pursuant to the Invitation for Bid, Section 2.17.1. Staff recommends awarding the contract on an as-needed basis to four responsive and responsible bidders for the various bid items as shown below:

Bid Group 1: Medium Capacity Tanker Truck (3000-5000 gallons)

- GreenTeam Service Corporation d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation
- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.
- All Liquid Environmental Services LLC dba Johnson Environmental Services

Bid Group 2: High Capacity Tanker Truck (more than 5000 gallons)

- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.

Bid Group 3: Vac Truck Minimum Capacity of 3000 gallons

- GreenTeam Service Corporation d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation
- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.
- All Liquid Environmental Services LLC d/b/a Johnson Environmental Services

Bid Group 4: Attended Pump 10-inch

• EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.

Bid Group 5: Attended Pump 12-inch

- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.

Bid Group 6: Labor Pump Operator

- GreenTeam Service Corporation d/b/a Greenteam Service Corporation
- A & A Drainage & Vac Services, Inc.
- EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.

None of the bidders indicated its status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$50,000 for this contract. Funds for this contract, in the amount of \$50,000, are available in the FY 2022 Operating Budget in the accounts listed below. Future years' expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
