Dear Paul:

This letter is to confirm Comcast of Florida, LLC's request for a return of the security fund provided to the City of Fort Lauderdale (the "City") pursuant to the prior cable franchise agreement between the City and District Cablevision Limited Partnership locally known as AT&T Broadband. This request is made on behalf Comcast of Florida, LLC (formerly known as District Cablevision LP).

In addition to the information we have already provided to show the ownership history and name-change history of the cable operator in the City (District Cablevision LP), we are providing this letter indemnification agreement as further assurance for the City that Comcast of Florida, LLC is the party rightfully entitled to the return of the security deposit.

BY THIS LETTER AGREEMENT, COMCAST OF FLORIDA, LLC HEREBY PROMISES TO INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS BY ANY OTHER PARTIES CLAIMING ENTITLEMENT TO A REFUND OF THE SECURITY DEPOSIT PROVIDED BY DISTRICT CABLEVISION LP.

Should the City receive any such claim by any other party, it shall promptly notify Comcast of the claim so as to provide Comcast the opportunity to defend or respond to the claim. Comcast shall not be liable for any settlement of such claim entered into by the City without Comcast's consent.
