TITLE: Budgeted City Sponsored Events for 3rd Quarter 2023 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

On an annual basis, the Parks and Recreation Department produces numerous City sponsored events with approved budget amounts from the City Commission. As requested by the City Commission, staff is presenting proposed events for the upcoming quarter.

The following City sponsored events are scheduled to be held between July 1, 2023 and September 30, 2023. The total budget allowed for each event is noted in parenthesis.

- Fourth of July Spectacular (District 2, \$400,000)
- Starlight Musicals (District 2, \$6,000 per event)
- Summer Jamz (District 3, \$100,000)
- David Deal Playday (District 3, \$15,000)
