Homeland Security, Urban Area Security Initiative, State of Florida
Division of Emergency Management through the City of Miami, FY 2023
Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), for \$354,517 - **(Commission
Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the acceptance of grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management in the amount of \$354,517; and authorize the City Manager to execute any documents needed to accept the funds.

Background

The United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$13,802,313.00 through the FY 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. The urban area is defined as Miami and Fort Lauderdale collectively. The sponsoring and coordinating agency is the City of Miami via a memorandum of agreement.

The City of Fort Lauderdale has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$354,517 with no required match and is a reimbursement grant. Funds will be used towards Emergency Operations Center EOC Enhancements (\$65,843); Ft. Lauderdale Police Department Cybersecurity Equipment and Back Up System Enhancement (\$101,324); Ft. Lauderdale Fire Rescue Hazmat Team monitors and Leak Control Equipment (\$81,000); Ft. Lauderdale Fire Rescue Technical Rescue Team Equipment and Trailer (\$106,350). The grant period began September 1, 2023, and ends August 31, 2026.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive impact to the city for \$354,517. This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 24-0322.
