A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DENYING THE APPLICATION BY 915 BEVERLY, LLC, A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY FOR A DOCK PERMIT FOR THE INSTALLATION, USE, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF A PROPOSED 50'+/- LONG X 8' +/- WIDE MARGINAL WOODEN DOCK AND ACCESS STEPS EXTENDING A MAXIMUM DISTANCE OF 5'+/- FROM THE SEAWALL CAP ON PUBLIC PROPERTY ABUTTING THE WATERWAY ADJACENT TO 915 SE 2ND STREET, PURSUANT TO SECTION 8-144 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE.

WHEREAS, Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida provides that the City Commission may grant a dock permit; and

WHEREAS, 915 Beverly, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (hereinafter "Applicant"), owns the Property located at 915 SE 2nd Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33301, Property ID# 5042 11 08 0080 (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant applied for a permit to install, use, maintain and repair a proposed 50'+/- long x 8'+/- wide marginal wooden dock and access steps extending a maximum distance of 5'+/- from the seawall cap on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 915 SE 2^{nd} Street, (hereinafter "Application"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That each WHEREAS clause set forth above is true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after reviewing and weighing the documentary evidence and testimony of those addressing the Commission at its Regular Meeting of June 17, 2025, as to the Application for a permit to install, use, maintain and repair a proposed 50'+/- long x 8'+/- wide marginal wooden dock and access steps extending a maximum distance of 5'+/- from the seawall cap on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 915 SE 2nd Street, and the same is hereby denied.
