A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DENYING THE APPLICATION BY JAMES G. MUELLER, A SINGLE MAN, FOR AN AFTER THE FACT WAIVER OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) FOUR (4) POST BOAT LIFT EXTENDING A MAXIMUM DISTANCE OF 31' +/- INTO THE WATERS OF THE ADJACENT RIO GRANDE CANAL PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 47-19(e) OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS ("ULDR"), FOR PROPERTY 100 HENDRICKS ISLE, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Section 47-19.3(e) of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida Unified Land Development Regulations (hereinafter "ULDR") provides that the City Commission may waive the limitations of Sections 47-19.3(c), or 47-19.3(d) or both, under extraordinary circumstances; and

WHEREAS, James G. Mueller, a single man (hereinafter "Applicant") owns the Property located at 100 Hendricks Isle, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33301, Property ID# 5042 02 19 0600 (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant submitted an application for an after the fact Waiver of Limitations to allow the installation of one (1) four (4) post boat lift extending a maximum distance of 31'+/- from the Applicant's Property line into the waters of the adjacent Rio Grande Canal (hereinafter "Application");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That each WHEREAS clause set forth above is true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after reviewing the evidence finds that the after the fact Application for a Waiver of Limitations to install one (1) four (4) post boat lift extending a maximum distance of 31'+/- from the Applicant's Property line into the waters of the adjacent Rio Grande Canal fails to meet the criteria set forth in ULDR Section 47-19.3 (e) and is therefore hereby denied.
