TITLE:	Motion to Consent to Assignment of Contract for Security Guard Services

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission consent to an assignment of contract, in substantially the form attached, for security guard services from Navarro Security Group, Inc. to Raven Protection Service Inc.

Background

On January 5, 2016, the City Commission approved a two-year contract with two oneyear renewal options for security guard services with Navarro Security Group, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$400,050 (CAM 15-1631).

Raven Protection Services Inc. purchased Navarro Security Group, Inc. on May 5, 2016, and has been performing Navarro Security Group, Inc.'s duties, obligations, and responsibilities under the original agreement since that time.

Resource Impact

There will not be an additional fiscal impact to the City.
