TITLE: Resolution Terminating an Employment Contract With and Discharging
Alain E. Boileau, and Providing an Effective Date of February 18, 2023 -
(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

That the City Commission consider a resolution terminating the Employment Contract of Alain E. Boileau ("City Attorney") effective February 18, 2023.

Background

On September 7, 2018, the City of Fort Lauderdale and Alain E. Boileau entered into an Employment Contract. On December 20, 2022, the City Commission approved a motion placing City Attorney Alain E. Boileau on administrative leave for a period of sixty days pending termination of the Employment Contract. Pursuant to Section 5 of the Employment Contract, the City Attorney may be removed or discharged only by duly adopted resolution after sixty days written notice. Mr. Boileau verbally waived the notice requirement. The effective date of the termination of the Employment Contract is February 18, 2023.

Resource Impact

The severance provision of the contract will be calculated less the sixty days' notice of termination.
