TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the Execution of an Underground Electric Utility
Facilities Easement with Florida Power and Light Company – Prospect Lake
Water Treatment Plant – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the execution of an Underground Electric Utility Facilities Easement with Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) for the purposes of construction, operation, and maintenance of underground electric utility facilities.

Background

The construction of the new Prospect Lake Clean Water Center (Water Treatment Plant) is currently underway. Once completed, the Plant will have the capability of producing 50 million gallons of water per day utilizing nanofiltration and ion exchange technology.

The Plant is being constructed under a Comprehensive Agreement between the City and IDE PLCWC, Inc (Ridgewood Infrastructure and IDE Technologies), as approved by the Commission on February 7, 2023 (CAM #23-0196). Per the Comprehensive Agreement, the City is required to provide two (2) electrical power feeds to the new plant. On August 22, 2023, the easement for the first feed was approved by the City Commission and has been completed (CAM #23-0745). A second feed is required for redundancy.

On April 15, 2025, an easement for the redundant power supply located in the utilities wellfield was approved by City Commission (CAM #25-0398). Upon further review, it was determined that FPL requires a second easement for a section of land located within Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) property. These two (2) easements allow FPL to construct, operate, and maintain the electrical power supply to the new Plant. The proposed Utility Easement is described in Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this item.
