**TITLE**: Discussion on the Draft Public-Private Partnerships Ordinance

(Commission Districts 1,2, 3 and 4)

The City Attorney's Office presented a preliminary draft public-private partnership ordinance at the October 17, 2023, City Commission Conference Meeting. The proposed ordinance is intended to supplement Section 255.065, Florida Statutes and not supplant it in accordance with Section 255.065(14)(d), Florida Statutes. At that meeting our office was directed to provide the City Commission with a document that compares the proposed ordinance with the requirements of Section 255.065, Florida Statutes and obtain feedback from the Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations (the "Council") before bringing the proposed ordinance back for discussion.
