Maintenance and Support for the Motorola 800 MHz P25 Trunked Radio System Equipment, Systems Upgrade Agreement, P1-CAD Interface, Components - Motorola Solutions, Inc. - \$587,948.64 - (Commission

Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an Agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the proprietary purchase of annual maintenance and support for the Motorola 800-megahertz (MHz) Project 25 (P25) Trunked Radio System Equipment, Systems Upgrade Agreement (SUA), P1-CAD interface, and components from Motorola Solutions, Inc. in the estimated annual amount of \$587,948.64.

Background

The City, via the Information Technology Services Department, operates a three (3)-site Motorola 800 MHz P25 Trunked Radio System with over 1,400 two-way subscriber radios for Police, Fire, and other City personnel. The P25 Trunked Radio System and two-way subscriber radios are vital communication elements on which public safety personnel rely for ongoing communications, collaboration, coordination, response, and mitigation of emergency incidents. The equipment utilized requires routine maintenance and repairs. Contractually, only Motorola-trained and authorized contractors may perform maintenance work on the P25 Trunked Radio System.

Since 2015, the City Commission has approved proprietary purchase agreements with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for annual Maintenance and Support for 800-MHz P25 Trunked Radio System and equipment.

Approval of this proprietary purchase agreement will provide continued support to the mission-critical radio system equipment, SUA, P1-CAD Interface, and peripheral equipment.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(3), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may purchase proprietary items, as defined in Section 2-173, without the necessity of competitive solicitation. The current radio system, infrastructure and components are proprietary to Motorola Solutions, Inc., procured through existing executed
