TITLE: Resolution Supporting Broward County Traffic Engineering Division to Post
“NO THRU TRUCKS” Signage at the Southwest Corner of East Sunrise
Boulevard and NE 16th Avenue - **(Commission District 2)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution supporting the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (BCTED) to install “NO THRU TRUCKS” signage at the southwest corner of East Sunrise Boulevard and NE 16th Avenue.

Background

Transportation and Mobility Staff received a neighbor request for the existing “NO THRU TRUCKS” sign to be replaced due to its condition. During a site inspection, BCTED determined the leaning sign to be hazardous to pedestrians and vehicular traffic, and as such, it was removed. BCTED had no record of a previous resolution approving the sign at described location and is requesting a resolution to be passed to reinstall signage.

The Traffic Engineering Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County requires the City Commission to approve a Resolution of Support. City Traffic Engineering staff recommends the installation of a “No Thru Trucks” sign at the at the southwest corner of East Sunrise Boulevard and NE 16th Avenue to enhance public safety in described residential area.

The installation of this sign is recommended to enhance safety of the residential street by alerting commercial truck drivers of the restricted movement within the area.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
