**TITLE:** Public Hearing Approving the Issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Frankie’s Shuttles LLC to Operate Two Low Speed Vehicles within the City of Fort Lauderdale - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

---

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing Frankie’s Shuttles LLC to operate two (2) for-hire low speed vehicles within the City of Fort Lauderdale.

**Background**

Per Chapter 27 of the City’s Code of Ordinances, it is unlawful for any person to engage in, or carry on the business of operating for-hire transportation services within the City without obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Vehicle for Hire applications are reviewed by staff for sufficiency before they are scheduled for City Commission approval. Risk Management will review the Certificate of Insurance prior to the issuance of any permits.

Frankie’s Shuttles LLC applied to provide service in the City utilizing two (2) low speed vehicles which are registered with the State of Florida as a four-wheeled vehicle capable of speeds up to 25 MPH and may operate on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 MPH or less and are not considered golf carts per Florida State Statute 320.01(22). Staff reviewed the application (Exhibit 1) in which the applicant proposes to operate with the sole purpose of providing a private, for-hire transportation service. Staff has found the application to be acceptable and recommends the approval to operate on City roadways.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
