Re: Fiscal Year 2013/2014 Ad Valorem Tax Downtown Development Authority

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2005-346, Laws of Florida relating to the Downtown Development Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby levies on all real and personal property subject to an ad valorem tax, lying within the "Downtown" area of Fort Lauderdale, as defined in Chapter 2005-346, Laws of Florida, a tax of 0.5080 mills for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014 for the purpose of financing the operation of the Authority, plus a tax of .5366 mills for debt service payment for the bonds of said Authority. This action was taken by the City Commission on October 15, 2013, by unanimous vote and adoption of Resolution 13-193.
