### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve a First Amendment to the Agreement between Limousines of South Florida, Inc. (LSF), and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Community Shuttle Service, in substantially the form attached, and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.

# **Background**

On February 5, 2021, the City of Fort Lauderdale and LSF entered a three (3) year agreement for operations and maintenance of the Community Shuttle Service.

In accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract and pursuant to mutual consent, on February 12, 2024, the agreement was extended for an additional 2-year period.

The First Amendment to the agreement modifies the agreement to incorporate service changes and provisions approved as part of the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Community Shuttle Service, approved by the City Commission on March 19, 2024 (CAM 24-0251).

The First Amendment includes:

- 1. Revisions to the route schedules:
  - a. Beach Link (additional 2.5 hour per operating day),
  - b. Downtown Link (additional 2.5 hour per operating day)
  - c. Las Olas Link (additional 3.5 hours per operating day)
- 2. Modifications to the list of Leased Vehicles to account for an additional vehicle
- 3. Adds provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

# Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action as the additional revenues are being reimbursed for the additional expenditures by the Broward County.

# FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF COMMUNITY SHUTTLE TRANSIT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF COMMUNITY SHUTTLE TRANSIT, made this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ 2024, is by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipality, ("City"), whose address is 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301-1016, and Limousines of South Florida, Inc., a Florida corporation, ("Contractor" or "Company"), whose address is 2766 NW 62<sup>nd</sup> Street, Miami, Florida 33147 Email: <a href="mailto:mlevitt@losf.us">mlevitt@losf.us</a>, Phone: 954-463-0845.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County entered into an Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Community Bus Service ("Interlocal Agreement") dated October 23, 2019, as amended, for the City, as a contracted public transit provider, to provide public transportation services to the residents of the City and those persons traveling within the City, to supplement the existing mass transit service provided by Broward County; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into an Agreement for Operations and Maintenance of Community Shuttle Transit ("Agreement") dated February 5, 2021 for an initial term commencing February 15, 2021 and ending on February 14, 2024, with the right to extend the agreement for two (2) additional two-year terms in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in RFP No. 12439-815 — OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF COMMUNITY SHUTTLE TRANSIT, and the Contractor's response to the RFP dated November 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2024, the term of the Agreement was extended by the parties for an additional two-year term at the existing pricing, terms, and conditions, and is scheduled to expire on February 14, 2026; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2024, the City approved a Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement to retroactively increase County funding to the City for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023, revise route schedules for new service, that were approved on January 5, 2022, amend the list of Leased Vehicles utilized by the City, and add certain provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter into a First Amendment to the Agreement ("First Amendment") to reflect the revised route schedule, amend the list of Leased Vehicles utilized by the City, and add certain provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct in all respects and are incorporated by reference herein.
- 2. The route schedule is hereby amended to reflect an additional 2.5 hours per operating day to the Beach Link, an additional 2.5 hours per operating day to the Downtown Link and an additional 3.5 hours per operating day to the Las Olas Link, as indicated in Exhibit A attached to this First Amendment and incorporated herein.

- 3. The list of Leased Vehicles utilized by the City is hereby amended to account for an additional vehicle for Fiscal Year 2024, as indicated in Exhibit B attached to this First Amendment and incorporated herein.
- 4. Section DD. of the Agreement is hereby amended to include the following provisions:

Contractor represents and certifies that it does not use any equipment, system, or service that uses covered telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system, as such terms are used in 48 CFR §§ 52.204-24 through 52.204-26. Contractor shall represent and certify that contractor shall not provide or use such covered telecommunications equipment, system, or services during the term.

If the Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and City of Fort Lauderdale for Community Shuttle Service, and any amendments thereto are subject to the requirements of Section 26-125(d) of the Broward County, Florida Code of Ordinances, Contractor represents and certifies that it will comply with Section 26-125(d) of the Broward County, Florida Code of Ordinances for the duration of the term.

5. Except as modified by this First Amendment, all terms, covenants, obligations and provisions of the Agreement shall remain unaltered, shall continue in full force and effect, and are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed by the parties in every respect. If the terms and conditions set forth in this First Amendment directly conflict with any provision contained in the Agreement, then this First Amendment shall control.
