The anchor of the front yard is the old live oak that's been on the property for sixty years. Conveniently off-center in the front yard, it provides wonderful shade and directs the eye away from the driveway and garage.

Both the front and back yard are filled with palms, shrubs and bromeliads to create a beautifully manicured entrance to the home.
