## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE. FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBSECTION 2(a) OF PERSONNEL RULE XI OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, BY ADDING PRESIDENTS DAY AS A LEGAL HOLIDAY TO BE OBSERVED BY CITY EMPLOYEES. AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, OF RESOLUTION RESCISSION CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the minutes of the City Commission's Conference Meeting held on January 21, 2021, indicate that "[t]here was a consensus to recognize *President's Day* as a paid City holiday."; and

WHEREAS, a proposed amendment to Subsection 2(a) of Rule XI of the City's Personnel Rules to add Presidents Day as a legal holiday to be observed by City employees has been reviewed and approved by the City's Civil Service Board in a meeting held on January 20, 2023, in accordance with Subsection 6.04(c)(2) of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Subsection 2(a) of Rule XI of the Personnel Rules of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended to provide as follows:

Legal holidays. Legal holidays to be observed by city employees, unless such employees are otherwise required to be on regular duty, are identified as follows:

New Year's Day (January 1)

Martin Luther King's Birthday (third Monday in January)

Presidents Day (third Monday in February)

Memorial Day (last Monday in May)
