2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the ranking of firms and negotiated fee schedule and contract agreement, in substantially the form attached, for consultant services for a new Police headquarters with the top ranked firm, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. ("AECOM") in the Not to Exceed amount of \$6,000,000.00

Background

On March 12, 2019, City residents voted to approve a bond proposal enabling the City to design and construct a new Police Headquarters building and parking structure. The City released a solicitation in October 2019 seeking the services of a qualified consulting firm to provide professional services for the implementation of the 2019 Police Facility Bond in accordance to the 2018 Space Needs Assessment Study. The selected firm will be required to provide overall project design, construction administration and management.

The timeline of the solicitation process includes the following:

- October 2019 Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") 12335-206 was issued for Consultant Services for New Police Headquarters
- November 2019 The RFQ closed with a total of nine firms submitting proposals as follows: Architects Design Group; AECOM; CBRE-Heery; Dewberry Architects, Inc.; Hellmuth, Obata & Kassabaum (HOK), Inc.; Jo Palma & Partners; Leo Daly; PGAL; and Synalovski Romanik Saye. One of the nine firms indicated that they are a Minority Owned Business Enterprise, Women Owned Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise.

• December 2019 – The Evaluation Committee ("Committee") met to evaluate the responsive and responsible proposers from the list.

They were as follows: Architects Design Group, AECOM, Leo Daly and HOK.

The firms were ranked based on the evaluation criteria shown in the table below.

The evaluation Committee selected the following firms for further consideration and presentations: Architects Design Group, AECOM, Leo Daly and HOK.

 February 2020 – The Committee met to evaluate the presentations of the four selected firms. The firms' presentations were ranked based on the evaluation criteria shown in the table above and, after careful consideration, the Committee ranked the firms as follows:

Negotiations with the top firm have been completed and staff recommends contract award at the Not to Exceed amount of \$6,000,000.

As a part of this overall contract, AECOM will provide the following services:

- 4. Construction Documents
- 5. Permitting

- 6. Construction Administration
- 7. Post Occupancy
