**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for Fort Lauderdale Executive Taxiway  
Intersection Improvements – Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. - \$1,388,944

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, with Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., for Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) taxiway intersection improvements, in the amount of \$1,388,944.

**Background**

This project is for the demolition and re-construction of two areas within the airfield of FXE to correct the taxiway geometry in order to improve the level of safety at these locations. Currently, these areas allow for direct access from the taxiway to the runway. The new alignments will reduce the number of taxiway intersection crossings for pilots thereby reducing the risk of accidental runway incursions and will also conform to the current Federal Aviation Administration design standards.

The work includes pavement demolition, subgrade, limerock and asphalt paving; installation of new taxiway edge lights and guidance signs; pavement striping and sodding, and modifications to the airfield electrical vault.

On June 6, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No., 673-11931. Four bids were received on July 18, 2017. The bids submitted were reviewed for compliance with the specifications and Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$1,388,944 for the contract award and \$165,195 for estimated consultant and in-house project management fees for a total of \$1,554,139. This item is contingent upon approval and appropriation of the September 6, 2017 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM # 17-0752. Funds for this

purchase in the total amount of \$1,554,139 will be available in the FY 2017 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below:
