TITLE: Motion to approve the proprietary purchase of annual hardware and

software support for the Kronos Timekeeping system - \$59,797

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the proprietary purchase of hardware and software support for the Kronos Timekeeping system from Kronos (US), Inc. for an annual amount estimated not to exceed \$59,797.

Background

On June 18, 2013, the City Commission approved an agreement with Kronos to provide an organization-wide expansion of the Kronos timekeeping system currently used by Public Works, Parks & Recreation and Transportation & Mobility employees. Annual support for the existing system must be renewed. The new system must also be added to the support package.

Support is provided directly from the manufacturer and covers the physical time clocks, server software and licenses. The maintenance entitles the City to replace broken or defective time clocks, call Kronos support for operational questions or problems, and to have access to new versions of the software as they are released.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$59,797.
